

## BREAKAWAY SAFETY TASSEL

Breakaway safety tassel is pre-fitted to the lift cords so that when a horizontal force is applied to the cords entering the tassle it safely breaks away eliminating any hazardous loops.

Untangle and untwist cords. If the breakaway safety tassel is pulled apart:





OPERATION

For 3 cords: Place the loose cord in the opening in one half of the breakaway safety tasseland press the breakaway safety tassel together until it is fully For 2 cords: Press the breakaway safety tassel together until it is fully closed.

The product is maintenance free however we recommend that regular visual checks are completed to ensure that no components have been damaged, which could result in operating difficulties and/or cause a safety risk.

If any maintenance is required we recommend that the work is carried out immediately, by a reputable blind company.

We recommend opening and closing your blind regularly to maintain the please in the fabric manufacture and that please d blinds should be stacked ownight, at least once a week to maintain their pleat and shape.








### CLEANING
