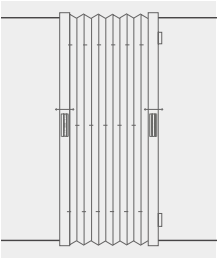

OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

OPERATION	MAINTENANCE	CLEANING
 To raise blind: Lift handle upwards until the blind reaches desired height. To lower blind: Pull handle downward until blind reaches desired height.	The product is maintenance free however we recommend that regular visual checks are completed to ensure that no components have been damaged, which could result in operating difficulties and/or cause a safety risk. If any maintenance is required we recommend that the work is carried out immediately, by a reputable blind company. We recommend opening and closing your blind regularly to maintain the pleats in the fabric. Recommended that pleated blinds should be stacked overnight, at least once a week, to maintain their pleat and shape.	To prevent blinds from becoming dirty, the blinds should be cleaned regularly with a feather duster.

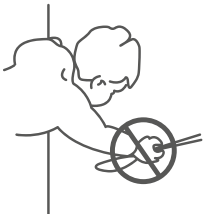


WARNING

Young children can be strangled by loops in pull cords, chains, tapes and inner cords that operate the product.

To avoid strangulation and entanglement, keep cords out of the reach of children. Cords may become wrapped around a child's neck. Move beds, cots and furniture away from window covering cords.

Do not tie cords together. Make sure cords do not twist and create a loop.

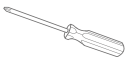

STEP 1

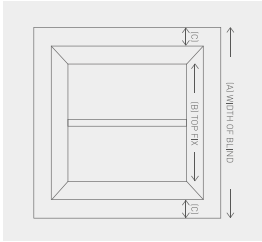
The installation of this product should be conducted by someone competent in DIY.

OUTSIDE RECESS

If the blind is fitted outside the window, ensure that measurement C is the same. Follow instructions for FACE FIXING. To calculate C $(A-B)/2$.

INSIDE RECESS

TOP FIX to the lintel, FACE FIX bracket to the window frame.

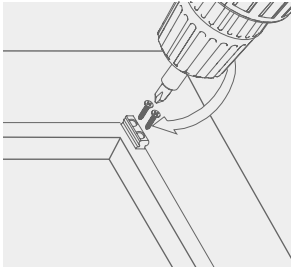


Children can strangle if a safety device is not installed. Always use a safety device to keep cords and chains out of reach of children.

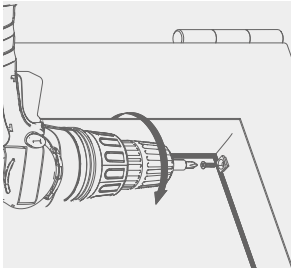
GLAZING BEAD

Install the window fasteners for the cord brackets, in the desired position using suitable fixings.

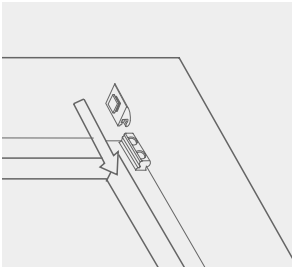


WINDOW FRAME
INSTALLATION

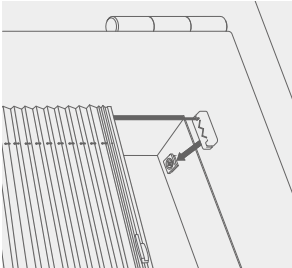
Install the window fasteners for the cord brackets in the desired position using suitable fixings.
